COMPLAINT / CHARGES / ALLEGATIONS: *(If applicable, refer to State Statute or General Order)*

On January 16, 2024, Captain Schott and I were assigned a review for possible policy violations occurring during an incident on September 29, 2023, related to incident number 23-46445, pertaining to Officer Ulrich's incident report and BWC discrepancies. Captain Schott and I immediately began to review the information received. In reading the reports, primarily Officer Ulrich's report, and reviewing BWC of the incident there is a concern that what was documented in a report by Officer Ulrich is not consistent with what is observed in other BWC footage of the incident. Furthermore, it does not appear Officer Ulrich had his BWC activated during the incident, and his report was unclear on if his BWC was on. We do believe there are possible policy violations including the below, but further investigation is needed.

Video/Recording Devices-18.16(3)(E)(3), 18.16(3)(E)(4)(b), 18.16(3)(E)(7), 18.16(3)(E)(2)

Both Captain Schott and I recommend a full internal investigation into this matter.
